# The United States President's visit to Jerusalem

## Parking and traffic arrangements

On Wed.-Fri., 9-11 Nissan 5773, Mar. 20-22 2013, wide-scale security measures will be taken which will affect daily routine and traffic in Jerusalem.

### Expected changes to traffic and parking:

#### No parking and vehicle towing

##### Wednesday, 9 Nissan, Mar. 20 2013

Admoni, King David, Hameches Square, Agron, Paris Square, Ramban, Rupin, Shmuel Weiss, Museum Row, Kaplan (between Rothschild and Rupin), Israel Museum parking lot, Arlozorov, Hanassi, Wingate Square, Smolanskin, Keren Hayesod, Plumer Square, Balfour, Ha'Ari, Émile Botta.

##### Thursday, 10 Nissan, Mar. 21 2013

Admoni, King David, Hameches Square, Agron, Paris, Ramban, Rupin, Shmuel Weiss, Museum Row, Kaplan, Ben-Zvi, Shazar, HaNasi HaShishi, Binyanei HaUma, Israel Museum, Museum parking lot, Binyanei HaUma parking lot, Keren Hayesod, Smolanskin, Arlozorov, Plumer Square, Jabotinsky.

##### Friday, 11 Nissan, Mar. 22 2013

Admoni, King David, Meches, Paris, Ramban, Agron, Rupin, Wolffsohn, Herzl Boulevard, Ish Shalom, Farbshtein Beyth, Uziel, Bayit Vegan, Holland Junction, HaPisga, Yad va'Shem, Mount Herzl, Wise, Museum Row, Givat Ram. Parking is prohibited in the aforementioned streets. Vehicles parked despite this order will be towed to the Gan HaPaamon or Givat Hatachmoshet parking lots.

#### Traffic route closures

**King David Street** – the route from Keren Hayesod junction (Plumer Square) to Agron junction (Hameches Square) will be closed off completely for vehicles on all three days of the visit, with the exception of area residents (who'll need to present an identity card including the slip with address only).

**The following streets and those leading to them will be closed off to traffic intermittently for a few hours during visit days:**

Agron, Ramban, Rupin, Hazaz, Shmuel Weiss, Museum Row, Burla, Jabotinsky, Hanassi, Smolanskin, Keren Hayesod, Ben-Zvi, Shazar, Kaplan, Israel Museum parking lot, Arlozorov, Balfour, Aza, Ha'Ari, Nassi, Ben-Zvi, Shazar, Herzl Boulevard.

#### Light Rail

During most visit days the light rail will continue operating normally, except for times the motorcade will move close to the track's route or cross it.

#### Public Transportation

Disruptions are expected on all public transportation lines all across the city. For details Call Kav service center \*8787.
